

2023 VETERANS PARADE INFORMATION

Parade Line-Up Route: Snake River Avenue is the parade formation line up; it is only open to ONE WAY traffic ONLY! For participants coming from Clarkston, please use Southway Bridge and turn North onto Snake River Avenue. For all others please travel south on 21st street-then west on 16th Avenue, then North down Snake River Avenue.

LINE-UP BEGINS: 8:00 AM to 10:00 AM: Participants are assigned a number please make them visible on your parade entry. There are numbers painted on the pavement to assist you in knowing where to "fall in" to the parade formation as well as volunteers in golf carts zipping up and down Snake River Avenue to help you find your spot.

NUMBERS PICKUP: Please pick up your numbers at the Parade Information Tent set up next to the Lewiston Skate Board Park on Snake River Avenue from 8:00 am to 10:00 am; volunteers will be there to assist you and answer any questions you may have that morning.

STAGING AREAS: Les Schwab, The Lewiston Community Center and Twin River Bank have graciously given their permission for us to use their Property for staging and disbanding areas. Specifically Les Schwab empty lots on <u>West side of</u> <u>Lincoln Street</u> which is behind their store at 1408 Main Street, The Lewiston Community Center parking lot on the <u>East side of Lincoln Street</u> which is behind their building at 1424 Main Street, (next to Les Schwab) and Twin River National Bank at 1507 G Street.

BAND ENTRANTS: We have you lining up on PROSPECT AVENUE. There will be a volunteer on Prospect Avenue who will assist in feeding the bands into the parade when their entry number comes up.

EQUESTRIAN ENTRANTS: We have positioned your entry to be away from loud noises (motorcycles, semis, etc.). Here are a few other items to help in making the parade a success and fun for your group.

Please stay off the grass at Primeland Co-Op at 1200 Snake River Ave.

You can park horse trailers at the Les Schwab empty lots on Lincoln street which is behind their store at 1408 Main Street, The Lewiston Community Center parking lot on the <u>East side of Lincoln Street</u> which is behind their building at 1424 Main Street, (next to Les Schwab).

You will need to provide your own pooper scoopers and equipment and are required to clean up after the horses in the parking areas along the parade route.

If you have participated in the Lewiston Round-up Parade we utilize the same route.

SAFETY INFORMATION FOR ALL PARTICIPANTS:

South Bound Lane for Snake River Avenue must be clear at all times.

- Please use caution when approaching the equestrian entrants on foot or during line up, so as not to startle the horses.
- During the parade, if you have equestrian entrants in front of you, please be alert and try not to make loud noises while moving down the parade route.
- Please keep 25 feet between you and the parade but make sure you keep up with the entrant in front of you to avoid huge gaps in the parade.
- When throwing candy to children along the route please make sure you put some muscle behind it so that the children are not running in front of the next parade entrant.
- Please heed all instructions from the law enforcement assigned to the parade as well as the signage placed by Lewiston's Public Works Department!
